# Swift Shift – Treatment Methods for Anterior and Posterior Cross-bites

Course Description: Perhaps the “demilitarized zone” (DMZ) of orthopedics and pediatric dentistry may be found in the early detection and treatment of anterior and/or posterior cross-bites.

As clinicians, all of us prefer to base our treatment on principles that are evidence based. We yield to that obligation. As professionals, we strive to provide accurate information to parents whose children present with occlusal relationships that, if left untreated, may lead to conditions that can be both unattractive, dysfunctional and become more severe.

So, what light can be shed on these questions:

- What are the potential consequences of advising to not treat the anterior and/or posterior cross-bite and wait until all the permanent teeth are in occlusion and what is the best time to correct these problems?
- Clinically, what are the most effective anterior and posterior cross-bite correction appliances and how are they adjusted by the doctor?
- If a patient has both an anterior and posterior cross-bite, does it matter which is corrected first?
- What is the best method to correct a true unilateral cross-bite?
- What should I do if my treatment method is not working?
- What should I do if my treatment mechanics are actually making the problem worse? For example, what if the patient develops an open-bite, and/or TMJ dysfunction during anterior or posterior cross-bite correction?
- When confronted with an anterior cross-bite, which are Class III problems with eventual ortho-surgical potential?
- What are the best post-treatment retention methods?
- Which patients have the highest cross-bite relapse potential; what factors are responsible for the relapse and what can be done about that risk?
- Which specific orthodontic records are needed prior to cross-bite correction?
- Which specific informed consent documents should be used?

For this seminar, our attention will include specific answers to these questions. Participants will receive a detailed syllabus and are assured of a clinically useful, motivating, and entertaining educational experience.
