Behavior 101 – Non-pharmacologic Management of Behavior in a Pediatric Dental Practice

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This presentation will focus on building the foundations of behavior specifically for a pediatric dental practitioner. With the behavioral foundations in place you will be introduced to several behavioral procedures that can be incorporated in your daily practice. These techniques have been derived from empirically validated behavioral and neuro-scientific practices. What is unique about this presentation? While there will be theoretical discussion of behavioral procedures, the audience will have an opportunity to view their inclusion in practice via video demonstration and case presentation. Although advance behavior guidance procedures will be part of the toolbox, it is plausible that with improved behavioral foundation, fewer patients may require them.

- Behavioral procedures and practical applications in day to day management of -patients - Desensitization, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Anxiety and Phobia Management, Gagging Response, Selective Eaters (picky eaters), Working with Young Children and more.

SPEAKERS:



Purnima Hernandez, DDS, MA, BCBS – Dr. Hernandez is a board certified pediatric dentist and behavior analyst who has been serving the communities of New York and New Jersey for over 20 years. Dr. Hernandez received her education in Pediatric Dentistry at Columbia University College of Dental Medicine. After serving as an Assistant Professor for many years in the department of Pediatric Dentistry she decided to pursue a career in the clinical practice of pediatric dentistry. In 2005 she established her own office in Fair Lawn, New Jersey. She then pursued a Masters in Applied Behavior Analysis from Caldwell University, New Jersey. While she delivers care to all children, her special interests are treating children with special healthcare needs. She is currently pursuing a certification in an integrative medicine program to better understand stress and nutrition. It is her vision to integrate knowledge from these three disciplines and develop protocols to help children.

Dr. Hernandez is also a parent of a child with disabilities. She is an advocate not just for her child but other children in the community. She has spoken to audiences on various topics related to disability such as health, advocacy, therapy, and special needs dentistry, and has authored and coauthored articles related to disability issues. She has served as Council Member on the council of Developmental Disabilities in New Jersey and is a board member of Disability Rights New Jersey.

Dr. Hernandez was awarded the Dr. Solomon Rosenstein Visiting Professorship and Fellowship by the Columbia University of College of Dental Medicine for her contribution to the field of special needs dentistry. She was also awarded the Francis Black Humanitarian award in health care by Friends Health Connection, an award that recognizes individuals from New Jersey's health care facilities who are an extraordinary inspiration to others.



Zachary Ikkanda, M.S. Ed, BCaBA – Mr. Ikkanda is a board certified assistant behavior analyst (BCaBA) and holds a Master's Degree in Special Education and Behavior Disorders. He has worked with children and adolescents with autism, learning disabilities and behavior disorders for over fifteen years. Mr. Ikkanda began his career as an instructor at a school for children with autism spectrum disorders in California where he employed the principles of behavior analysis to teach children with autism spectrum disorders. He also worked as an instructor in a clinical setting in New York before becoming a home programming therapist working with a variety of learners and families throughout the tristate area.

Mr. Ikkanda has assisted in the development of home and community based programming for individuals ranging in age from 4 -18 and has extensive experience training teachers and parents to implement programming in a variety of environments.
