# **Dentistry from the Cradle to the Grave: Helping Dentists Recognize and Report Abuse/Neglect and Human Trafficking along with a Discussion on the Role of a Forensic Odontologist**

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This lecture will consist of a morning section and afternoon section. The morning section will begin with a discussion of domestic violence including how to recognize signs in children, spouses, the elderly, and disabled. The morning session will also discuss malpractice and fraud using a case that presented to Dr. Kenney's own practice and how he addressed it. The afternoon section will begin with a discussion on Human Trafficking including how prevalent it is and how to recognize signs in a dental setting and what to do if you suspect it is occurring. The afternoon will also have Dr. Kenney talking with us about his work as a forensic odontologist and the role of dentistry in helping to identify victims of murders, missing people, and mass casualties. There will also be information on further training or certification in all topics discussed.

## **COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

Domestic Violence including Human Trafficking

1. Become aware of the signs and symptoms of all forms of Domestic Violence (Child, Intimate Partner, Elder, Disabled) and the signs of Human Trafficking
2. Learn the action to take when a possible case of Domestic Violence presents in the dental office including reporting to State registries
3. Better understand the breadth and depth of Human Trafficking here in the US and worldwide.
4. Learn how to report cases of suspected Human Trafficking to Law Enforcement.

Forensic Odontology including Malpractice

1. Understand how forensic dentistry makes its contribution to the medico-legal system, be it routine identifications or mass fatality incidents
2. Learn why keeping accurate complete records is so important in the identification and malpractice litigation
3. Learn what to do if confronted with a case of gross malpractice in a patient that presents at your office as a new patient.
4. Learn about further education available and requirements for those interested in actively participating in forensic dentistry.

## **Speaker Biography Dr. John P. (Jack) Kenney**



Dr. Kenney received his dental degree in 1977, his certificate of Specialty in Pediatric Dentistry ('79) and a Master's Degree in Oral Biology ('79) all from Loyola University of Chicago. He was in private practice for 37 years in Park Ridge IL. He is board certified in Pediatric Dentistry and Forensic Odontology (the only such dual boarded dentist) He is a Fellow of the American College of Dentists, The International College of Dentists, the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, and the American Academy of Forensic Sciences. He is a Life Member of the ADA and the AAPD. His forensic education includes the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology (Walter Reed AMC), University of Texas HSC San Antonio, St Louis U Medical School, The FBI Academy, and The National Emergency Training

Center/National Fire Academy. Beginning with the American Airlines DC 10 crash in Chicago he has participated in 8 major mass fatality incidents including 9-11, served as the Chief Forensic Odontologist and Disaster Team Director for the Cook County Medical Examiner's Office (Chicago metro)(1984-1997) and Deputy Coroner and Director of Identification Services for the DuPage County IL Coroner's Office (1997-2013). As a member of DMORT, the Federal Disaster Mortuary Operations Response Team, he was the primary Odontology Consultant to the National DMORT Commander during 9-11. He is one of two dental and three anthropological consultants to the U.S. Joint POW MIA Accounting Command Central Identification Laboratory at Hickham AFB HI. Currently he is a consultant to the Davidson County TN Medical Examiner's Office. He has lectured on 5 continents; In the US, at the FBI Academy, the Smithsonian Institute and the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology along with numerous ADA, State, regional and local dental societies. He was a consultant to the ADA Council on Dental Practice and a speaker for the ADA Lecture series. He was elected twice as President of the American Board of Forensic Odontology, was Vice-Chair of the Forensic Sciences Foundation and represents the Odontology section on the Board of Directors of the American Academy of Forensic Sciences. . He was on the editorial board of the Journal of Forensic Identification and the Journal of Forensic Sciences. He has published numerous book chapters and articles on forensic dentistry and the dental aspects of child abuse/domestic violence. He has completed hundreds of identification and bite mark cases, and testified over 100 times as an expert witness in court. He currently splits his time between Chicago and Nashville TN.
